Definitions

- 1) Mapping to object terminology in into - **Action Henry** will re-work the requirements spec to indicate the separation between transport and packaging/enveloping
- 2) Definition of Transaction - various folks to complete definitions as follows
 - a) "ACID" transactions (TBD) - **Action John I** to do
 - b) "EDI" transactions (TBD) - **Action Dick** to do
 - c) "Conversational" transactions (TBD) - **Action John I** to complete
 - d) "Read-only" transactions (TBD) - **David B to do - Done**
- 3) Add definition of Message Manifest - **Action David B** to do a definition - **done**
- 4) Should we (or not) include support for recovery from the failure of responses to arrive: YES - **Action David B** to do - **Done**
 - a) acknowledge receipt (I've got it and won't lose it)
 - b) acknowledge acceptance (documents checked including authentication, can be OK or in error)
 - c) substantive response (business response)
- 5) Add a picture to explain the flow of messages that can occur covering request messages and the above from 4. **Action David B** to do **Done**
- 6) Service Definition - does it need clarification ?? - Needs a picture - **Action David B** to do - **Done**
- 7) Add in a definition of an "application" e.g applications can invoke services - **Action David B** to do **Done**

Requirements

- 1) How do we do discovery of properties of services - need to add in as a requirement. **Action David B - Done** to do. Should include:
 - a) policies, e.g quality of service, time out info, acks, request, reply,
 - b) document choreographies
 - c) security
 - d) reliable messaging
 - e) transport protocols
- 2) Priorities:
 - a) There two views of priorities:
 - i) indicates sequence in which messages in a queue should be processed
 - ii) indicates priority in which messages should be processed by its recipient
 - b) need to define how priorities are not abused - **Action David B** to do something
- 3) Do we need to provide a service that indicates that a server is too busy to process a message within expected timeframe - congestion management - Add to requirements - **Action David B - Done**

- 4) NEW Envelopes and headers are used inconsistently **Action David B - Done**
